- War Memorial-Cllr Robinson; there are grants to help restore damaged memorials. It needs to be inspected, the Parish Council requested £1000 of the repairs and renewals budget to be ring fenced to help towards the cost of restoring this iconic memorial.
- Benches appear to be stable at the present time no maintenance is required
- The Hawkesbury Notice board has become a health and safety issue as the posts of the board have become rotten and needs replacing-it was agreed for M & G to replace these posts as soon as possible to prevent any injuries.
