- 1. Please could South Gloucestershire Council clarify the circumstances under which conditions can be altered or removed? Hawkesbury Parish Council is under the impression that conditions are an important element of the planning application. Hawkesbury Parish Council supported variation 6 in planning application PK12/2134/RVC and objected its removal. The dry stone wall would have enhanced the border of this property.
- 2. Why was it conditioned in the first place if it is subsequently easy to remove?
- 3. Why is there no explanation on the decision for its removal?
