## 7 District Councillors report information only - Cllr Hope

As reported last month – it appears that Hawkesbury Upton will not be included in the upgrade to superfast broadband. The 90% target has been met by BT and as a consequence the village suffers. This is very frustrating for many of us who have been lobbying for many years.

There are three exchanges which serve the parish, Wickwar, Sodbury and Didmarton and all suffer in some way or other, although Wickwar is on the list to receive the upgrade. I have had a meeting with our local MP and council officers as well as local business people to investigate ways forward. Another national funding bid is to start.

Cllr Hope contacted AED regarding the fitting of the Defibrillator cabinet and it is hoped to be fitted as soon as possible. The Parish Council have agreed to cover these costs.

A meeting has been held with HURG and Council Officers regarding the future of community composting sites across South Gloucestershire. The Council option to support this is very expensive; savings of £2.7million have to be made. A cheaper option is being investigated, and a consultation will shortly be published on the future of the sites. One of the options will be for support from Parish Council's and grant funding.

A reminder that the village shop although currently in the process of being registered as a community asset, still requires customers and from the recent piece in the magazine – it really is a case of use it or lose it.

Planning-there is a joint meeting on Thursday to discuss draft Policies Sites & Places document. This is a long document which includes responses from the parish councils outlining their aspirations. Cllr Hope understands there will be further consultation in the summer with those parishes who have asked for housing.

A consultation has started on a 20MPH speed limit in Chipping Sodbury a further consultation on Climate Change has been launched.

As a result of the work currently being undertaken by the Council's Strategic Planning Policy and Specialist Advice Team regarding the Policies Sites and Places DPD with the Parish Councils, there have been a number of requests for a housing needs survey.

The Council is exploring options for funding and carrying out surveys as resources are limited, and will need to decide how to prioritise which surveys to progress. This is work has begun and we will consult you in due course.

It would be useful to know at this stage whether or not your Parish has the resources to appoint an independent consultant to carry out your own housing needs survey, the Strategic Housing Enabling team would be able to provide guidance.
