<b>PK11/1454 /F</b>	Wallcroft, Back Street, Hawkesbury Upton Badminton South Glos	Erection of first floor side extension to facilitate the sub access and associated works.	Hawkesbury Parish Council support the alterations to the building. However we have concerns over the new access regarding the near bend to the north and the width of the road at this point, is it practicable to retain the existing access to the proposed parking area and retain the existing Cotswold stone wall. Please could Highways visit the site to assess both vehicular and pedestrian safety. The Cotswold wall to be altered to
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form a new access is on top of a bank, is the ground level on the applicants side to remain the same or will there be a slope in the access? This will affect the height of the modified Cotswold stone wall for visibility on egress and ingress. What is the intended retained height of the Cotswold stone wall? In the `Design and Access Statement` it states that the new access will greatly improve safety for users of Back Street; there is no footpath for pedestrians and the road appears to be at its narrowest point for the new access
