Another reminder ...

- When you have finished with your tools including ladders, make sure you put them away in a secure location out of site.
- Fit a metal grille on any garage or shed windows to secure them.
- Screen shed or garage windows using curtains or frosted glass so contents from within cannot be seen.
- Fit a shed or garage alarm.
- Permanently mark bikes and power tools with your postcode and registering them for free at www.immobilise.com
- Use a 'Sold Secure' closeshackled padlock to secure a hasp and staple fitted with coach bolts or tamper-proof screws on both your gate and shed.
