#### Question 1 Rural Housing

The Parish Council considered all the responses received from the draft Policies Sites plan consultation and at this moment in time the Parish Council wants to maintain the existing "Building Development Boundary".

One of the action points from the Parish Plan was that the Parish Council was to have an analysis of the housing need.

The Parish Council wishes to undertake a housing needs survey with the South Gloucestershire Council at the earliest opportunity B

The Parish Council does not wish to pursue a rural exception site until the result of the housing needs survey has been established.

This was resolved by Cllr Hope proposing the above response, which was second by Cllr Musty and put to the vote - all in favour.
