8 Cemetery

Cemetery sub committee minutes 13th March 2010

8.1 Paragraph 5 charges

A recommendation to the Parish Council to raise the current charges by 3% for both Parishioners and for non Parishioners.

A vote was made to accept the proposal. Cllr Otley proposed to accept the increase over a 2 year period.

8.2 Paragraph 6 More space required

Points raised;

Full capacity of cemetery by 2050 and the reutilising of graves 100-175yrs old, It was felt that no more space would be required. It was agreed to accept this.

Only accept Parishioners or strong Parish connections to use the cemetery.

8.3 Paragraph 7 Ashes plots

A recommendation to the Parish Council to grant extra space between Ashes plots –to be considered 2 per grave instead of 3 and that the designated area be Row's S & T numbered 1-6. **Extra space granted**
